Secretary's Report: Minutes from the May meeting accepted as is and placed on file.

Treasurers' Report: Diane Waclawski reported a beginning balance of \$2,886.23 as of May 1. Not all checks have cleared yet. The bake sale earned \$453.00. As of May 31st, the balance was \$2963.70. By the end of June this balance needs to be \$500. We have committed \$1700 to our fall retreat costs. With the clearance of the upcoming checks, we are left with the need to spend \$467.66. Following some discussion Noreen Broering made a motion to buy a \$200 Visa card with \$5 activation fee and the remainder monies be designated toward a new pascal candle base. Carina Conklin supported the motion and all agreed. Lisa Galbraith will buy the Visa card.

Bills: Kim Jensen presented a bill for pizza for the sum of \$ 110.77. Char Zionskowski presented a bill for computer software \$105.99.

Denise Elsenheimer summarizes:

- Bids for the east parking lot have been reviewed. The cost of asphalt and sidewalk will be \$41050.00. At present we have \$4000 in funds for these costs. In addition, we need to fix the roof and bell tower for a cost of \$6340.00. The diocese has approved a \$40,000 loan. We will begin a fund raiser soon.

CSA has reached 48% of our goal.
